Our Mid-Week Secondary Winter Programs

Our day sessions are designed to introduce students to **cross country skiing** and **snowshoeing**. Fully certified instructors will provide a **30 minute ski lesson**. After the lesson, students, teachers, and parent volunteers can use our marked trail system.

French instructors are available upon request. **Sit skis** are available for students with little to no mobility below the waist. **Guides available** for visually impaired students.

If skiing and snowshoeing, ski rates apply. If students are using their own equipment, public rates apply.

For safety and proper fit, it is recommended that participants use Highlands Nordic rental equipment.

*Teachers and volunteers ski and snowshoe for FREE! This is with the expectation that they will help students with their skis, ski boots, snowshoes, and trail supervision.

Winter Program 1: Cross Country Skiing/Snowshoeing

Skiing: students will have a half-hour lesson in which they learn proper skiing techniques. After the lesson, students, teachers, and parent volunteers explore nature unique to the Niagara Escarpment, along our marked trail system.

Fees include a trail pass, half hour lesson, and classic no-wax equipment.

Snowshoeing: per session, the class may choose one of: winter survival, shelter building, predator/prey survival game, wildlife hike, or Trappers and Traders.

Fees include a trail pass, snowshoes, and a snowshoe guide/outdoor interpreter.

Winter Program 2: Curriculum Based Program & Cross Country Skiing or Snowshoeing

This program is offered to students in grades 1-6

Curriculum based- half day: a select number of Science/Geography/Social Studies programs are offered year round. Students spend half day indoors with **hands-on, inquiry-based learning** as they rotate through a series of dynamic **activity centres**.

Winter Facilities

Our **24 km** of ski trails are 25 ft wide and groomed for both classic and skate skiing techniques. Our scenic **7km** of snowshoe trail will lead you through a seemingly secluded winter wilderness. Both networks offer a variety of distances and degrees of difficulty for all ages and abilities.

Our **Rental Shop** offers a full size range of boots, skis, poles, snowshoes, and sit skis. A full service Pro-Shop and Repair Shop will be open daily for any service needs.

Our **Full Service Cafeteria** is at your disposal. A selection of hot and nutritious lunches are available for purchase. We also welcome your group to bring their own lunches and snacks if they choose.

Canadian Ski Patrol toboggan and snowmobiles are always ready for an emergency.

Washrooms, change-rooms, seating areas and conference rooms make our lodge versatile.
